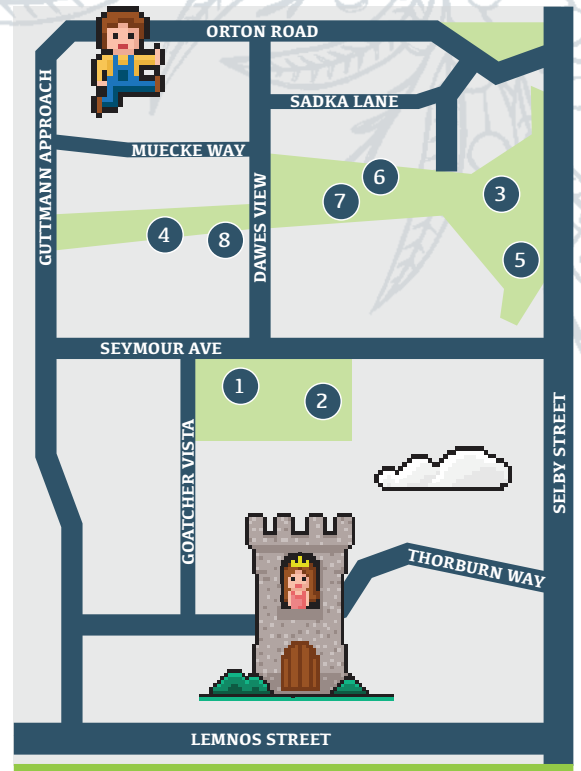

These concrete pavers were used across the hospital site, but they have a slightly different use now... Can you find them? HINT: Try looking for different colours.


